### First Moore en Español

There are a lot of exciting things happening at First Moore right now. Of course, we have the remodel underway, and I am happy to tell you that we have received our final permitting, so construction will ramp up soon.

We are continually seeing new faces as we gather every week. God is connecting us to new people regularly, and we are seeing real connections take place. These connections are happening in nearly every age group, but we are seeing an apparent increase in young adults and families. One example is a new Life Group that began for young adults in their twenties just 12 months ago. It started with four people, which were the leaders, and now has just under 20 attending. This is one of several similar instances and proves we have much to be thankful for.
